BEWARE OF THESE COMMON SCAMS!

Work From Home Scams: Make big money working part-time at home. Sound appealing? That's why these scams are so popular. Jobs can be posted to social media sites, like Facebook or LinkedIn. The fraudsters may send you a check to buy materials, like a computer, then request you send the unused portion back to them in a gift card. The check will be fraudulent and there is no job. It's possible that you've also provided your DOB, SSN, or other personal identifiers.

Crypto Investment Scams: Guarantees and big promises. Celebrity endorsements, like Elon Musk, for example, are ways to get your attention and entice you into investing in cryptocurrency scams. Fraudsters will make fake investment sites that look real, but once "invested" you cannot find your money. Fraudsters may ask you to wire or send a gift card and then they invest the money in their names. Celebrities don't need you to invest in things with them!

Facebook Quizzes: What is your spirit animal, what Harry Potter character are you most like, what kind of dragon are you? Hours of harmless fun or scams? Scammers may hide malicious malware in what seems to be a friendly quiz. Some quizzes will fool you into revealing information about yourself or your household. Hackers will use the information to build fake profiles to steal your identity or hack into other accounts.

Tech Support Scams: Tech support scammers want you to believe you have a serious problem with your computer, like a virus. They're going to create a sense of urgency, causing you to act fast. They often ask you to pay by wiring money, putting money on a gift card, prepaid card or cash reload card, or using a money transfer app because they know those types of payments can be hard to reverse. These could be pop-up warnings on your computer or phone calls pretending to be from a well-known company.

Romance Scams: Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Eventually, they will ask for money. If someone you meet online needs your bank account information or your online banking credentials to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

What can you do? Stop! Never give your personal information out until you have done your research. Use words like "review," "scam," or "complaint" in your search. You can research or report scams to the Federal Trade Commission at www.ftc.gov. Not all work from home, Crypto investments, or Facebook quizzes are scams. It is up to you to stay safe!

SKIP YOUR PAYMENT!

Qualified members may opt to skip one or more of their Frontier Community Credit Union loan payments. In addition to some extra room in your budget, you'll also help a worthy, local organization!

Simply fill out the Skip-a-Pay form available at frontierccu.org, and we'll skip your designated loan payment and donate a portion of your \$20 fee to United Way of Leavenworth County*. Submit a form at least five days before the payment date you wish to skip.

Even if you don't have a loan with us, you can still help United Way! We'll accept donations, and the entire amount will go to advancing education, health, and income in our community. United Way is a 501(c) (3) organization and can provide a tax statement to anyone who requests one.

*Skip-a-Pay is subject to approval and requires a \$20 fee per loan. Credit card accounts and real estate loans are ineligible. All accounts with the credit union must be in good standing. You must have made at least one monthly payment on the loan(s) indicated on the form to qualify. Skip-a-Pay requests will be accepted for loan payment dates beginning 10/1/22 and must be submitted no later than five days prior to the payment due date.
